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PATHWAY RULES

- Keep Right, Pass Left
- Pass Safely – Be prepared to yield
- Announce your presence before passing
- Obey Traffic Laws
- Move to the side when you stop
- Single file when others approach
- Dogs must be under control
- Scoop the Poop

STREET RULES

BICYCLISTS

- Ride with traffic
- Obey Traffic Laws
- Signal your intentions
- Be predictable
- Be visible
- Wear a helmet

PEDESTRIANS

- Find the safest place to cross the street
- Look left, look right, then left again
- Be predictable
- Obey Traffic Laws

TRAIL RULES

- Check for allowed uses
- Bikes yield to others
- View wildlife from afar
- Reduce trail wear; avoid muddy trails
- Prevent erosion; don't short-cut trails
- Announce your presence before passing
- Dogs must be under control
- Scoop the Poop
